1. Reality of God's Desire

For Christ died for our sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. (I Peter 3:18)

...Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. (4)... He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures... (I Corinthians 15:3b-4)

4. Real Response

When you respond by faith to Jesus as God's remedy for your spiritual needs, Jesus comes to you in a real spiritual encounter and forms a relationship connection with you. He forgives you and makes you a member of God's eternal family.

Yet to all who received Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God. (John 1:12)

The Spirit himself testifies with our spirits that we are God's children. (Romans 8:16)

You can respond to Jesus by praying. To keep it real, we've used ordinary words in this model prayer.

Lord Jesus, I believe that You died on the Cross and rose again so that I can be forgiven. I know that I am separated from You by the wrong stuff that's in my life. I'm sorry. Please forgive me. Right now I turn from the wrong stuff and give my life to You. I ask You to come into my heart and take control of my life.
